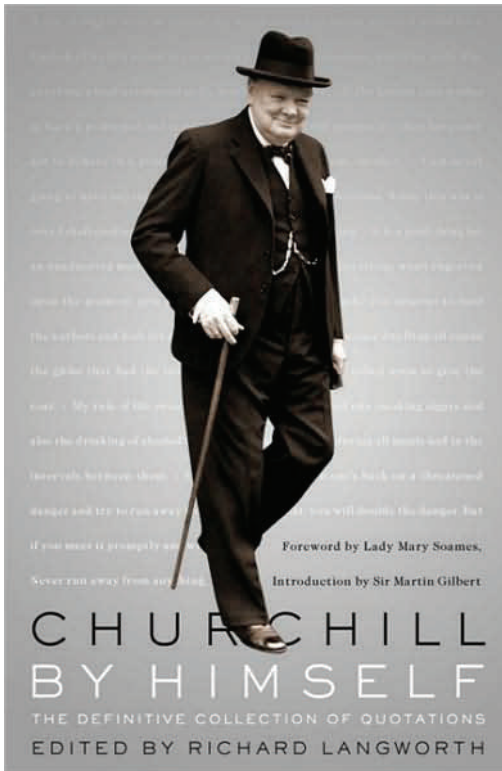

Winston Churchill is one of the twentieth century's most oft-quoted leaders—and one frequently misquoted or quoted out of context. Yet his actual remarks were often much wiser and wittier than reported. *Churchill By Himself* is the first exhaustive, attributed and annotated collection of Churchill sayings. Edited by longtime Churchill scholar Richard M. Langworth and authorized by the Churchill Estate, the quotations provide the first wholly accurate record of the great statesman's words. Mr. Langworth will sign copies of the book at the event.



Richard M. Langworth CBE, editor of *Churchill by Himself: The Definitive Collection of Quotations* (PublicAffairs 2008), founded the predecessor to The Churchill Centre and Museum at the Cabinet War Rooms in 1968 and has been editor of *Finest Hour* since 1981. He was the Centre's first president in 1995-99 and has chaired its Board of Trustees since 2000. He studied history at Wagner College, served with the U.S. Coast Guard, was senior editor of *Automobile Quarterly*, and has been a freelance writer since 1968. To forty books on automotive history he added in 1998 *A Connoisseur's Guide to the Books of Sir Winston Churchill*. In 1998 he was named a Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire for promoting knowledge of Sir Winston and Anglo-American understanding.
